

MORNING AND EVENING REMEMBRANCES

Reciting the morning and evening remembrances is an act of obedience to Allah. He says in the Quran,

“So glorify Allah in the evening and in the morning—all praise is for Him in the heavens and the earth—as well as in the afternoon, and at noon.” (Translation of the Noble Quran 30:17-18)

He also says, *“Call on me, I will answer you. (40:60)”*

The second verse above is a powerful one because Allah is asking us to call onto Him, AND in the same phrase, He is telling us that He WILL respond to us, He WILL answer us, He WILL help us out. That is the power of the belief of making dua. Allah tells us He will answer us.

No dua is ever meaningless. Allah wants us to keep asking Him for what we desire. Our provisions come from Him. He is The who can provide to us, no one else. That is why for Allah the best thing is for his creation to keep asking him for blessings and never get tired of doing so.

There is a saying that when you want to talk to Allah, you should pray salah and recite dua and when you want Allah to talk to you, you should read the Quran, and the Quran very clearly tells all of us to call on Allah at all times.

Calling on Allah does not only mean reciting duas when we are in need and miseries. Calling on Allah also means to do so when we have been given a blessing. If Allah has made us happy we should call on Allah and tell Him (highly glorified is He) how immensely grateful we are. For Allah has asked us to be grateful for all the many blessings we have and not to be arrogant or ungrateful. In the same way when we are afflicted with a misery Allah has asked us to call on him so that He may help. Allah says in the Quran “Remember me and I will remember you.” Allah is All Hearing, All Knowing, All Seeing, Most Forgiving, Most Generous, All Merciful...and so much more. He again asks us to call on Him.

In the Quran Allah has given us proof of Him answering to us when we call on him. He has told us how immensely close He is to us. He says: “And We have already created man and know what his soul whispers to him, and We are closer to him than [his] jugular vein” (50:16). Allah has said He is closer than our jugular vein because that is the vein that is in the neck and hence closer to a human. But Allah, Most High, is closer to us than even that. Then why do we not call on Him, make dua to Him and ask Him for what we desire?

It is only when we have complete faith in the Omnipotence of Allah, when we will believe that He can do anything, when we believe that what Allah gives us is for our benefit and what He does not give us is ALSO for our benefit—that is when our faith is actually complete. What Allah has given to us NOONE can take away and what Allah has chosen NOT to give us no one can give us that. He is the Planner. He is the allocator and He is the Sustainer. So call out to Him and see your prayers being answered. See the blessings that you will experience when you call out to Him. And disappointment will never touch your life. This is Allah’s promise and He subhanwataala keeps His promises.

None has the right to be worshipped but You alone without partner and that Muhammad, peace be upon him, is Your slave and messenger. Ameen.
- Oh Allah, whatever favor has come to me is from You alone without partner so for You is all praise and unto You all thanks. Ameen.
- Oh Allah, grant my body health. Oh Allah, grant my hearing health. Oh Allah, grant my sight health. None has the right to be worshipped except You. Oh Allah I take refuge with You from disbelief and poverty and I take refuge with You from the

punishment of the grave. None has the right to be worshipped except You. (3x) Ameen.

- Allah is Sufficient for me. None has the right to be worshipped except Him. Upon Him I rely and He is Lord of the Exalted throne. (7x) Ameen.

- None has the right to be worshipped except Allah, alone, without partner. To Him belongs all sovereignty and praise and He is over all things Omnipotent. (100x) times. Ameen.
- We have reached the morning and at this very time all sovereignty belongs to Allah, Lord of all the worlds. Oh Allah, I ask You for the good of this day, its triumphs and its victories, its light and its blessings...and its guidance, and I take refuge in You from the evil of this day and the evil that follows it. Ameen.

- Oh Allah, I ask You for knowledge that is of benefit, good provisions, and deeds that will be accepted. Ameen.
- Oh Allah, I ask You for Paradise and seek Your protection from the fire. Ameen.
- Glory is to Allah. Praise is to Allah. There is no god but Allah. And Allah is The Most Great. Ameen. *Subhanallah walhamdulillah wala ilaha illallah wallahu Akbar.* (100x). Ameen.
- There is none worthy of worship but You, Glory to You, surely I was among the wrongdoers. Ameen.
- Oh Allah, Ever Living, Oh Ever Sustaining, in Your mercy I seek relief. Rectify for me all my affairs and do not leave me to myself, even for the blink of an eye. Ameen.
